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1 INTRODUCTION

De Aar Solar Power (RF) Pty Ltd, hereafter referred to as "the Client", invites qualified and experienced service providers to submit proposals for conducting a comprehensive assessment of its Enterprise Development (EnD) Programme.

Since inception, the programme has aimed to support local Small, Medium and Micro Enterprises (SMMEs), situated around its 50km radius, with the goal of enhancing business revenue and profit, stimulate job creation and increase business sustainability within the project's beneficiary communities.

This RFP seeks to evaluate the impact, effectiveness, and sustainability of EnD interventions undertaken to date.

The primary objective of this engagement is to conduct an **independent, evidence-based review** of the Enterprise Development Programme. The review must determine:

- The post-intervention performance and sustainability of these enterprises.

- Recommendations to enhance the future impact, structure, and delivery of the programme.
- Pragmatic plan to form and maintain a strategic multi-IPP structure within the 50km radius of the solar park.
